

# Report on NRA Reference Data for $^{10,11}\text{B}$ , $^{14}\text{N}$ , $^{19}\text{F}$ , $^{32}\text{S}$ , $^{6,7}\text{Li}$

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## 1. Remarks

In order to facilitate the forthcoming evaluation, we would like to add the following remarks, concerning the cross section data reported in the total\_new.xls (Excel) file.

1. The list is by no means complete and it will be constantly updated. We sincerely apologize in advance for all the papers we might have omitted from the list, as well as for possible errors. Our only excuse is the lack of time due to the upgrade of the accelerator and the heavy work load of all of us...
2. There are no graphs included, due to the fact that several of the papers mentioned provide only a couple of points relevant to NRA. Nevertheless, if Matej requires the results only in graphical form we will try to help him as much as possible, taking into account though, that extra information is needed (old papers give results in the c.m. frame, etc.)
3. Whatever is highlighted in red or marked with red colour, corresponds to literature already included in IBANDL.
4. All the papers in bold, black letters have been retrieved and studied. For the rest we have severe difficulties to analyze and/or comment on, due to their absence from the whole network of academic Greek libraries, both in hardcopy and over the internet. Nevertheless, we hope to increase our 'depository' in the forthcoming weeks.

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5. Due to all the above, we consider the results as premature thus far. We are sending the list now, due to the fact that the deadline agreed in the meeting between us unfortunately coincides with the orthodox Easter holidays for the universities. Thus Matej will have the time to study it and to notify us about the required changes and/or additions.
