SUBJECT: Conference Codes

We have noticed in dictionary 7 a free text comment stating that a CINDA codes is different from the EXFOR code given. As far as I can recall, this has not been agreed upon. The agreement is that if an EXFOR dictionary code is longer than eight characters, it should be truncated for CINDA.

It is impossible for our dictionary programs to pick up codes embedded in free text in the dictionaries, so we cannot agree to any exceptions. Therefore, 79JUELICH should be coded as 79JUELIC for CINDA.
