Subject: 4-C-MEMO Nr. 3/1-3

The difference between coding according to schemes I and II of 4-C-Memo 3/1 is not "slash obligatory" and "slash not obligatory" but "slash obligatory, CS-parameter" and "slash not obligatory, no CS-parameter".

In this respect we agreed in Moscow on two points :

1. the use of a CS-parameter; and
2. a maximum of two entries per field for fields 2-5 of the ISØ-QUANT. Separation by slash if two entries are used.

From this the answer to the above problem is quite clear: "slash not obligatory, CS-parameter".

The consequences are illustrated under III below :
