The following modification to dictionary D.2.7. is given, following discussions at the Moscow 4-centre meeting.

HISTORY. This keyword is used to document chronologically the handling of a work within the data center. The entry consists of a six digit date and a descriptive alphabetic character within parantheses, followed by free text.

Ex: (691015R) Date on tape ND 1234 from Ribon.

Dates that may be identified under HISTORY are as follows:

R - Date data received at the Centre

C - Date data compiled at the Centre

L - Date data entered into the bank

T - Date data translated from previous compilation

E - Date data exchanged between data centres

A - Date data altered

X - Date indentified in free text

The free text may also be used to identify the origin of the numerical data table.
