SUBJECT: Data Heading Definitions in BIB

We should consider (possibly for the NRDC working group meeting in September) whether to legalize the following usage when defining data headings in the BIB section, e.g., under ERR-ANALYS or EN-SEC. That is, allowing generic data headings to be used to represent all variations which may appear in the data section.

Examples:

- 1.) E may be understood to include the headings E, E-MIN and E-MAX.
- 2.) DATA-ERR may be understood to include the headings DATA-ERR, +DATA-ERR, -DATA-ERR.

It would save complications for compilers, but would mean additional complications for checking and processing codes.
