## Subject: Central storage of EXFOR source papers

NDS has been archiving sources of EXFOR entries as hard copies (photocopies of papers) for many years. Nowadays, EXFOR source materials are often available in electronic form, so they are stored also in NDS electronically (PDF, Word-DOC, images, etc.) during compilation.

<u>NDS</u> would like to have also electronic copies of papers compiled in other Centers. Since NDS became a coordinating center of EXFOR compilation, NDS could also be a central storage place of EXFOR source papers: NDS will organize an electronic library with EXFOR sources, which will be available to all Centers of NRDC (let's say, for inter-centers exchange).

<u>These materials will not be publicly available</u> (to avoid copyright problems with publishers). But nevertheless, they can be stored in EXFOR database and be accessed through the retrieval system with some restrictions. E.g., users can have access to these materials only locally, in one of the NRDC Centers. In the long-term perspective (who knows) some copyrights may become obsolete and more materials can be available for public. Anyway, this archiving can help us to prevent disappearance of EXFOR sources.
