NDS Open Area and Naming Convention

The original NDS open area (http://nds121.iaea.org/ndsx4/) has not been available since February 2012, and currently we are using the IAEA ftp site for data exchange. There are some inconveniences with this ftp site (*e.g.*, lengthy address, uploading without keeping the time stamp), and we would like to propose the NDS web site (http://www-nds.iaea.org/nrdc/ndsx4/) as the new NDS open area since December 2013 if there is no inconvenience to your centres. Note that

- 1. Centres will still need to send tapes to NDS staff (*e.g.*, by e-mail) for uploading to the open area.
- 2. It takes one day to make uploaded tapes visible after uploading.

Almost all centres are using prelim.nnnn and trans.nnnn though NRDC Protocol asks to use PRELIM.nnnn and TRANS.nnnn for naming. We propose to use lower cases as new naming convention.
