Subject: Suggested Details for the Agenda of 3rd NRDC-Meeting, Paris,  
 June 19, 1978

We would like to propose the following details for the agenda of the Paris-meeting:

1. Ad item 4:

- variable product nucleus formalism with all related topics (as requested in CP-C/35 and CP-D/62, too)
- final version of presently valid EXFOR-Manual and LEXFOR
- proposal to mark beginning and end of a 'comment by the compiler' within any kinds of free text containing also comments directly obtained from the original paper.

2. Ad item 32:

We would like to ask, whether the presently used procedure to perform alterations at already transmitted entries in the Kachapag-file can be accepted by the other centers, though it deviates from the official EXFOR-rules. This procedure, basing on the regular transmission of the entire Kachapag file and on the fact that we must maintain the master file on a tape and not on a disk, is as follows:

- a) Important alterations are indicated by an entry under HISTORY and a respective explanation. In addition, they are mentioned in a note accompanying each trans-tape. Alter flags in col. 80 are not given.

- b) We treat as important alterations changes in the REACTION string, in cross-references, in the DATA section, and possibly in the ERROR-ANALYSIS.
- c) Unimportant alterations which are all changes not mentioned under b) are performed without any notice.

We would appreciate it if the other centers could accept this procedure and we could keep it.

3. Ad item 33:

We hope to have prepared until the meeting a preliminary proof of a test-sheet of the printed version of the Kachapag-file and would like to submit it to the other participants for discussion and comments.
