1. Coding of Page Number for Journal

We have 3 journal codes for J. Phys. G:

JP/G: J. Phys. G

JP/S: J. Phys. G (Supplement)

JP/GL: J. Phys. G (Letter)

Why??

Why 3 codes defined for J. Phys. G?

Old rule (Systems Manual, May 1983 8.R.14)

*Page (Paper#) subfield, if present, contains:
the page number which must be **numeric**...*

Example - J.Phys.G.31(2005)S1759

(J,JP/G,31,**S**1759,2005) - Error

(J,JP/**G**S,31,1759,2005) - Okay

Now page number may have **alphanumeric**.

Page coding as given by publisher

Advantage (1) – for correct citation

Example: J.Phys.G31(2005)S1759

(J, JP/G, 31, S1759, 2005)

J. Phys. G31(2005) S1759 (perfect!)

(J, JP/GS, 31, 1759, 2005)

J. Phys. G S31(2005)1759 (incorrect)

Page coding as given by publisher (Cont'd)

Advantage (2) – for internet access to abstract

Example: J.Phys.Colloq.31(1970)C2-217

- *To change allowed character from alphanumeric character to any character.*

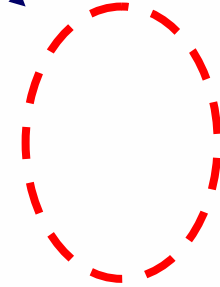
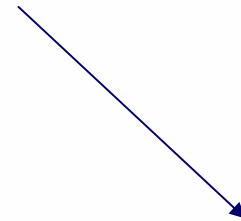
2. Report without page number

- Full paper are published in EANDC report (R, EANDC-50-S) with paper number without page number

(* ,code-number,(volume/part),page,date)

Proposed extension:

(* ,code-number,(volume/part),page(**paper #**),date)

(* = **P (Progress reports)**

or **R (Reports)**

or **S (Conference reports)**

To allow paper number for reports.
