There are three lists of compilation mistakes maintained by NDS.

1) Feedback on EXFOR

This is a collection of mistakes in contents found by EXFOR users and NRDC members.

2) EXFOR Format Error

This is a collection of format errors in EXFOR found by database administrators in NEA-DB, NDS and JCPRG (compiled by M. Bossant, NEA-DB). All mistakes reported in CP-E/121 (WP2007-18) are now included in this list.

3) EXFOR Suspicious Data (WPEC SG-30)

This is a collection of suspicious entries submitted from WPEC SG-30 members after the 2007 NRDC meeting. Now 3 lists from E. Duppont (CEA) are considered.

Note:

- When a new preliminary file is transmitted to the NDS open area, all subentries relevant to these lists are automatically detected and checked. If correction is done properly, the list is updated.
- Some corrections are possibly not considered in these lists because this checking program was introduced in June, 2008. Please inform me for update if your corrections are not considered in the lists.
- For the third list, compiler's comment or author's comment may be added under the keyword CRITIQUE or COMMENT without any change in numerical data if there is not a clear evidence of compiler's mistake.
