

Status of New Articles for EXFOR Compilation (A1)

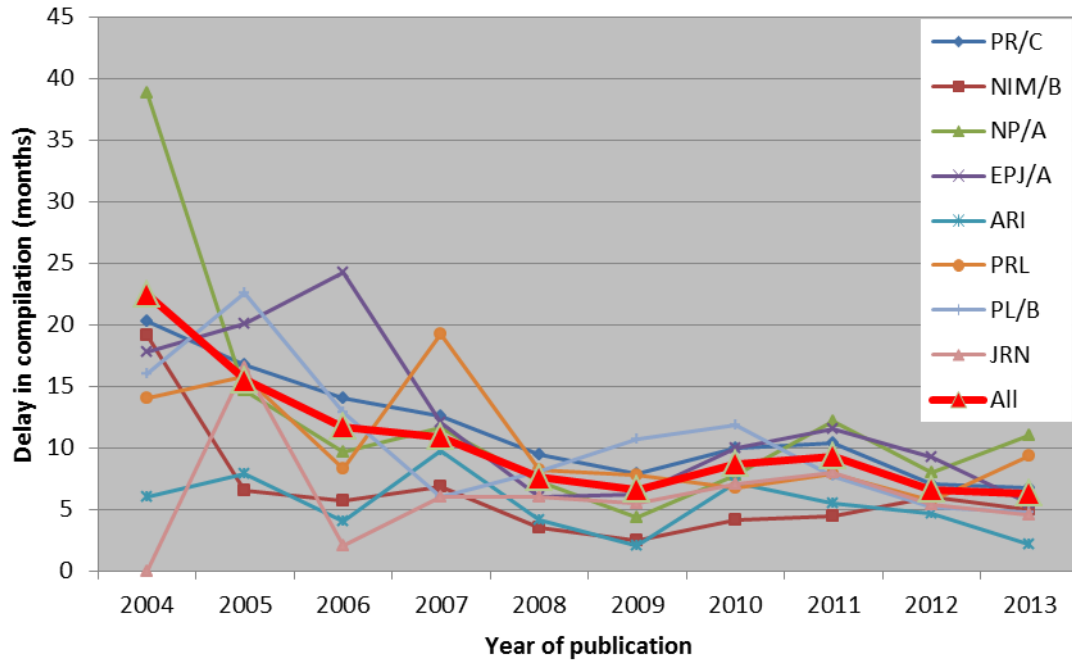


Fig. 1: Averaged delay in compilation for articles in selected journals

Figure 1 shows delay in compilation (= date of transmission – date of publication) for new articles published in selected journals (covering 67% of all registered articles, see also Appendix of the paper) and coded as the primary reference in new entries. The averaged delay is **6.3 months** for the articles published in 2013.

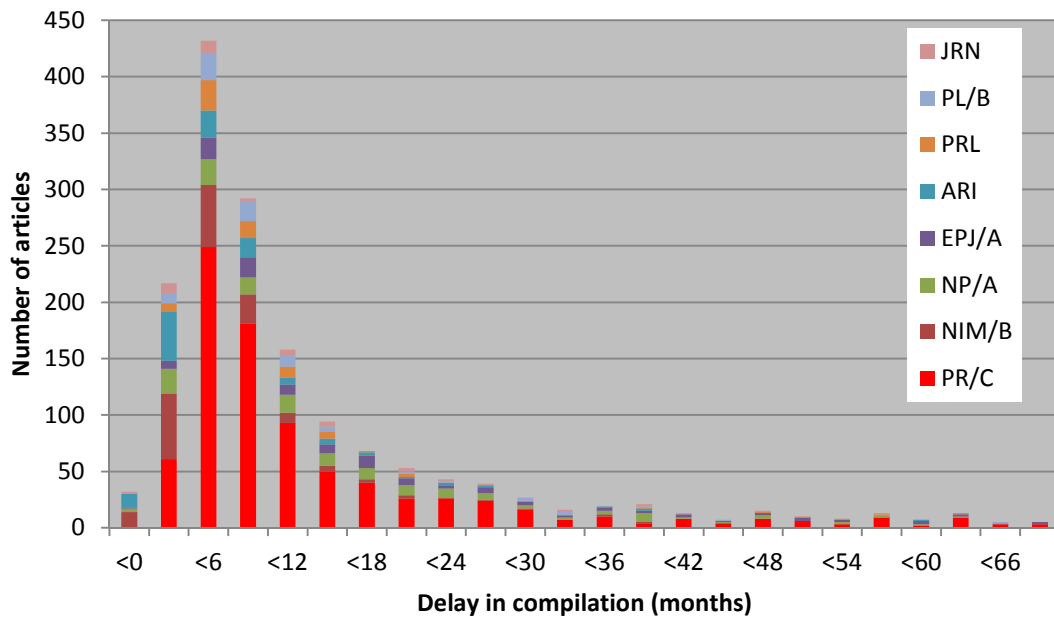


Fig. 2: Averaged delay in compilation for articles in selected journals

Figure 2 shows distribution of delay in compilation for the articles published in 2004 or later. An article is most probably compiled between 3 to 6 months after publication.
