Updating and Transmission Protocol

TRANS exchange

- Preliminary version of TRANS file is sent by FTP to NDS open area, as PRELIM.Xnnn
 - X=center identification character
 - nnn = sequential TRANS no. within center
- Address: ndsalpha.iaea.org
User NDSX4 (no password)
subdirectory NDSX4.TRANS.PRELIM
- Notify all centers. Then they have one month time for comments. Originating center must react to comments (correct or explain)
- The final version is sent as TRANS.Xnnn to directory NDSX4.TRANS and announced to all
- NDS then deletes Prelim version
- New subdirectory NDSX4.TRANS.PROBLEMS for problematic entries (temporarily) withdrawn (not copied to final TRANS)



Corrections

- In PRELIM stage (and before): informal, no bookkeeping necessary
- Once an entry was transmitted (and therefore processed by other centres): “Retransmission”
- **Retransmissions**
 - On subentry level (plus always subentry 1)
 - New date on ENTRY and SUBENT records
 - Recorded under HISTORY (remains in file)
 - Flagged in col.80 (important information for receiving centers, but not kept in file)

When to retransmit

- **Obligatory in case of any important correction or addition, such as**
 - **Modifications/additions received from author**
 - **Mistakes in DATA or correction of REACTION**
 - **New main reference**
 - **Addition or deletion of subentries**
 - **Change of STATUS, received author proof**
- **Optional for less important corrections**
- **Retransmissions are a regular part of the network business and a strength of the system!**

Alter flags in col.80

- **C (corrected): ENTRY and SUBENT records of retransmitted entries**
- **C Line corrected**
- **D Line(s) deleted following the flagged line**
- **T Two changes: record was corrected or inserted AND following line(s) deleted**
- **R Replace = block change, e.g. whole BIB section, or replace NOCOMMON by COMMON section**
- *** Subentry deleted (NOSUBENT record)**

Deletions of entries and subentries

- **Why delete a (sub)entry?**
 - Superseded, withdrawn, duplication
 - Combination of several subentries
- **How:**
 - **Subentry: whole subentry replaced by NOSUBENT**
 - **Entry:**
 - subentry 1 (keeping bibliographic keywords) remains in file, with HISTORY entry giving reasons for deletion
 - Other subentries replaced by NOSUBENT
 - **This is the ONLY way to delete entries / subentries!**
 - **NEVER re-use (sub)accession numbers of deleted (sub) entries!**

HISTORY

- Records history of (sub)entry from compilation through all retransmissions
- Date + (optional) code from Dict. 15, free text
- HISTORY (19940312C) OS
(19960711A) Data units
corrected
- Changes in (or before) PRELIM stage need not be recorded, but
- Later changes (retransmissions) must be recorded, and
- HISTORY entries are cumulative (must be kept for ever)
