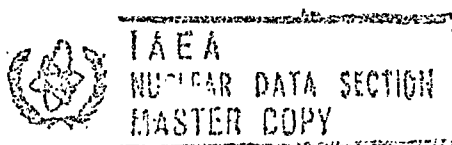

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INTRODUCTION

The reports which follow were presented to the AEC Nuclear Cross Sections Advisory Group at the Meeting on March 24-25, 1966 in Washington, D. C. These reports contain an informal statement of recent development, changes of emphasis, and preliminary data which are of importance to the cross section measurement program of the AEC. They are not intended to be complete or formal reports, nor do they cover all of the work in the laboratories relating to nuclear cross section measurements.
